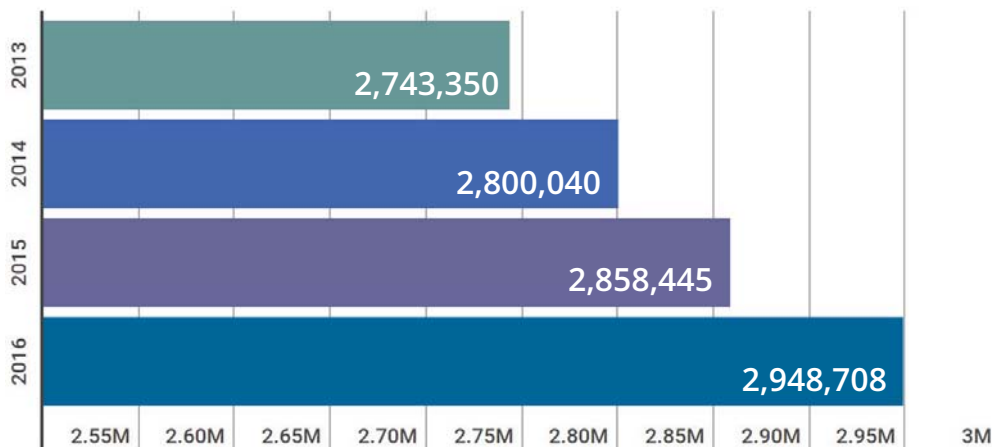


TOTAL NUMBER OF U.S. BUSINESS AVIATION FLIGHTS FROM 2013-2016:

QUICK FACTS:

- ✈ Flight activity rose 11 out of the 12 calendar months in 2016, totaling a 3.2% increase from 2015.
- ✈ Large cabin aircraft had the largest year-over-year increase, up 6.0%, with the G-IV fleet showing the most activity in that category.
- ✈ Gama Aviation, Executive Jet Management, and XOJet were the top Part 135 operators.
- ✈ KTEB, KFXE, and KOPF were the top U.S. airports for international flight activity.

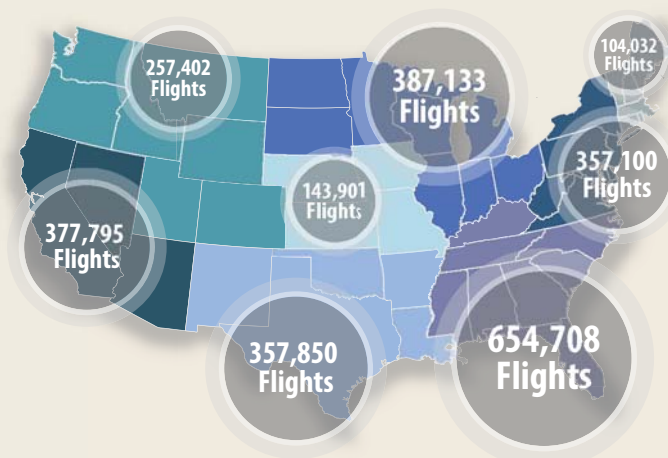

2016 Departures by FAA Region

The Western Pacific region recorded the largest year-over-year growth, up **8.0%**. The Southwest region was the only region to post a decline from 2015, down **0.4%**.
